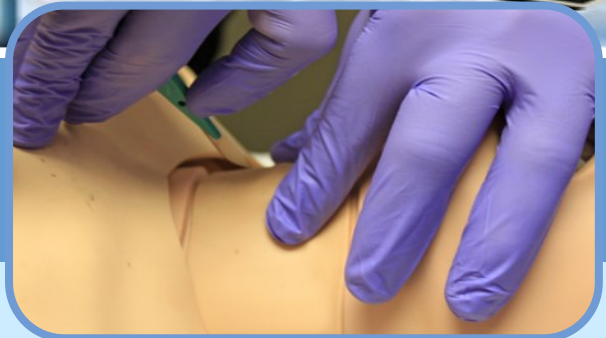


ADAPT

Airway Decisions and Process Training

A one day course for consultants and trainees (ST3 and above) in anaesthetics and emergency medicine that aims to equip individuals with strategies for managing adult patients with airway obstruction through integrated learning of technical skills and human factors that influence decision-making.

The course will:-

- **Present on the pathophysiology of airway obstruction**
- **Generate discussions on human performance limitations, decision-making processes and the use of guidelines**
- **Utilise mastery learning principles to ensure delegates gain experience in the following skills: Emergency surgical airway, Intubation via LMA, Nasendoscopy and Optiflow set-up**
- **Cumulate in an immersive simulation session followed by a facilitated debrief focusing on the human factors and challenges of decision-making in these complex clinical emergency situations**
